HOW TO MAKE A REPORT OF SEXUAL ABUSE

Child sexual abuse is a crime in the State of NH and the Church. NH law requires that anyone who has reason to suspect that a child is being or has been abused or neglected must make a report to the **Division for Children, Youth & Families ("DCYF") of the State of NH**, 1-800-894-5533. Any person who suspects or alleges child abuse on the part of a priest, deacon, employee, or volunteer of a parish, school, or institution of the Diocese of Manchester is also encouraged to make a report to the **Office for Ministerial Conduct** 669-3100.

All diocesan personnel (clergy, employees, and volunteers) in the Catholic Church in NH must comply with the *Code of Ministerial Conduct* and the *Policy for the Protection of Children and Young People*.
